*You must pay a \$100 deposit for each week you wish to reserve applied to balance. Camp are \$290 per week.

The answers to all of your questions about Camp Avalanche and Camp de Champs

Payments: You may pay in full or pay a \$100 deposit to reserve a spot for your child. If you pay a deposit, the remainder is due at the start of each camp week. **If you paid a deposit by credit card, your card will automatically be charged the balance due, at the start of the camp week.** The deposit is non-refundable inside of the 30 day cancellation period. Depending on availability for the week enrolled, deposits may be transferred up to two weeks in advance to attending. There are no daily fees. **Receipts should be picked up at check-in.**

Hours of Operation: Programmed Day from 9:00am – 5:00pm. Drop-off time is between 8:00 – 9:00am and pick-up is between 5:00-6:00 pm. You may pick your child up and drop them off at any time, but you will need to check your daily schedule (given out the first day of camp and posted on the website each Friday of the preceding week) because we may be in the middle of an activity or off-site. A few field trips may require that you have your child at camp before 9:00am and/or pick up after 5:00pm (Camp Avalanche). A fee of **\$1/ minute** will be assessed if you are late picking up your child after 6 pm. Please see the Terms & Conditions for late fees.

Daily Schedule: An hour by hour schedule for the week will be posted on the website by Friday of the preceding week. Camp De Champs daily schedule is posted for the whole summer.

Lunch: Campers should bring a sack lunch with a drink everyday that does not require refrigeration. We will provide a morning and an afternoon snack for all campers. Lunch arrangements will be made with local vendors information will be out mid-May. \$35 per week or \$7 per day.

Ice Skating: Camp Avalanche is a general day camp and skating is just one of our many activities. We do skate every afternoon and on Mondays all campers who are interested will receive a free group lesson with a Professional Chaparral coach. Camp de Champs is a skating training camp where the kids will spend the majority of the day on the ice improving their skating skills via classes, lectures and training.

Blizzard Blitz Classes for Camp Avalanche Campers: Camp Avalanche- The Learn To Skate program will provide a half hour lesson each day during camp skating time. The fee for campers is only \$20 per lesson, regular price is \$27 per lesson. Camp de Champs camp includes multiple lessons each day.

Skates: Rental skates are provided at no extra cost.

What if my child can't skate? Then you are enrolling them in the best camp possible! We have beginners through advanced skaters in both camps. We cater the lessons and the experience to fit both kinds of campers.

What to wear: Camp Avalanche- Campers should wear comfortable play clothes and closed-toe shoes and socks. Keep in mind we will have some outdoor activities each day and we will also be on the ice each day. Camper **MUST** pack warm clothes, gloves and a helmet is recommended for the ice. Camp de Champs- please wear warm, comfortable clothes, layers recommended, tennis shoes, long socks, no Crocs allowed. **Detailed outlines will be sent out to all camp attendees in the camp confirmation informing parents of what to bring and wear.**

What to bring: Both camps will send out confirmations with detailed lists of what to wear and bring. **Remember to label** all of your belongings. Chaparral Ice is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

What not to bring: We discourage bringing toys of any kind to camp. Gameboys, CD players, action figures, etc. are near and dear to us all and we would hate to see them misplaced or broken. If Electronic toys are brought to camp they may only be used during drop-off and pick-up times or in vehicles when going on field trips. Chaparral Ice is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Camp Counselors: Your child's safety is a priority at Chaparral Ice Center. We require our counselors to go through an extensive training program which includes a general camp counselor training and the following certifications: CPR, First Aid, Community Water Safety, Child Abuse Prevention and Blood-borne pathogens. Camp Avalanche and de Champs is licensed by the Texas Department of Health. It is our policy to maintain a 10:1 camper to counselor ratio.

Refunds: There is a 30-day cancellation policy. Refunds requested more than 30 days prior to the start date for a particular camp session will be processed **minus a \$25 non-refundable administrative fee**. Please see the Terms and Conditions form for details on refunds.

Liability: In case of sickness or accident, Chaparral Ice has my approval to secure, at my expense, such medical attention as deemed necessary, if unable to contact me. • My child is in good physical condition and has my permission to participate in all camp activities. • I authorize my child to travel to/from camp activities in transportation arranged by Chaparral Ice. • Space is limited and is first come first serve. Chaparral Ice reserves the right to cancel or close any camp sessions. • Campers assume the risks and agree that Chaparral Ice and its staff are not responsible for injury to the camper or for loss or damage to personal property. • At all times the camper shall be liable for personal injury and/or property damage or loss incurred while on the premises and the camper agrees to defend and hold Chaparral Ice Center, its officers, agents and employees harmless against any and all liability for claims, demands and causes of camper's use, maintenance and operation of the facilities or otherwise upon the premises or from the camper's negligence during the term of this agreement. Vaccination records are required from all Campers prior to attending camp.
