

2017-18 Chaparral Ice Adult Hockey – Fall/Winter Draft League A, B1, B2, C1, and C2 Divisions

*****NEW*** Chaparral Loyalty Program**

We are excited to offer a customer loyalty program to all players that register and pay for the Fall/Winter season. There are 3 tiers to the program:

Tier 1

- All registered and drafted players will have access to the Warrior discount website (35% off on all gear and apparel items.)
- All registered and drafted players will receive free unlimited skate sharpening for the first 2 weeks of the season (9/5-9/17)
- Catered end of season All-Star game.

Tier 2

- Tier 1 +
- 5% discount on published fees for all returning registered and drafted players from the 2016/17 Fall/Winter, 2017 Spring, or 2017 Summer seasons.

Tier 3

- Tier 1 and Tier 2 +
- EFT (payment plan) charge of \$25 is waived for any returning registered and drafted player from the 2017 Spring, or 2017 Summer season.

LEAGUE DETAILS – USA HOCKEY REGISTERED LEAGUE –

Registration: Open until Thursday, August 17, 2017 **OR** earlier if all spots fill before the deadline.

Late Registration: Once the league fills, all registrations received will go on a waiting list.

Number of Games: 25 regular season games plus at least 1 play-off game.

Play-off Format: Single Elimination. Pending final enrollment and league size.

Season Opens: Tuesday, September 5, 2017

Season Ends: Tentatively as late as Sunday, March 4, 2018

Game Days and Times: **Primary** game nights to be scheduled as follows: A=Wed/Fri, B1=Tues/Sun, B2=Mon/Thurs, C1=Mon/Wed, C2=Tues/Thurs. Secondary nights may be used on occasion when ice availability prohibits the use of a primary night.

Game Locations: Chaparral Ice-Northcross and HEB Center

Divisions and Teams: 6 A, 6 B1, 8 B2, 6 C1, 4 C2 (League will be capped at 30 teams total)

Game Format: NON-Check League. Three 13-minute stop clock periods with referees and scorekeepers. 3rd period Mercy rule in effect. No Tie games. All games will end with a winner. Tie after regulation will immediately go to 3-round shootout. Standings will be based upon a 3-point system.

Player Cost: \$699

Goalie Cost: \$382

*These prices are for payment upfront in full only and do not include any of the loyalty program discounts. For EFT payments, see below EFT section.

EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) payment plans are available for the season via EFT payments only. To do EFT payments, you must register in person. No on-line or phone enrollment will be allowed for EFT payments. There is an EFT fee of \$25 that is added on to the total registration price. The payment plan for the season is as follows:

Player Cost:

\$125 down and four equal payments of the remaining balance on or about the 1st of each month – October – January

Goalie Cost:

\$75 down and four equal payments of the remaining balance on or about the 1st of each month – October – January

IMPORTANT DATES AND EVENTS:

New Player's Skate: Chaparral Ice-Northcross, Sunday, August 20, 2017 @ 8:30 and 9:45 pm. Specific time slot you will attend will be determined by final new player enrollment at each division. All new players will be notified via e-mail prior to Saturday, August 19 as to the specific time slot they need to attend.

2017-18 Chaparral Ice Adult Hockey – Fall/Winter Draft League A, B1, B2, C1, and C2 Divisions

League Draft: Drafts will be completed by Friday, August 25, 2017. Date/time/location will be released to captains once finalized. Only captains are allowed/need to attend.

Team Notification: All rosters will be released to the captains shortly after the completion of the draft. Captains will notify their drafted players via e-mail. The schedule will typically be released on a month-by-month basis as the ice times @ HEB Center are not released until a month in advance. However, if known sooner, larger portions of the schedule may be released.

USA HOCKEY REGISTRATION: All players will be required to have current registration with USA Hockey for the 2017-18 season through USA Hockey @ www.usahockeyregistration.com if not already done so. Once complete, forward the online confirmation to the League Director, Jason Maurer @ jmaurer@chaparralice.com. Your USA Hockey registration must be up to date prior to registering for the league. Please note that registering for USA Hockey does not register you for the league and visa versa.

UNIFORMS: All players are required to wear matching jersey with unique #'s – GOALIES included. If teams do not have exactly matching jerseys, then the primary BASE color of everyone's jersey must be the same with unique numbers on each jersey (no duplicate #'s allowed). Home team is generally white/light and the away is dark.

HOW TO REGISTER:

On-line: (Any discount will be applied at the time the online order is processed)

****Payment Plans (EFT) are **NOT** an option when enrolling online.****

Go to www.chaparralice.com. On the lower left hand side, there is a section labeled "Quick Links". Click on "Enroll Online Now". A second browser window will open up. If not, then you will need to change your internet security options to allow pop-ups from this site. Scroll over "Program Registration" and select "Adult League" from the drop down menu. Click on "Check Available Time/Sessions". Select appropriate "Season" (Draft Fall 2017/18). Select Appropriate "Level". Click Continue. Failure to follow these steps can result in you getting registered in the wrong league/division or possibly not enrolled at all. When you register, make sure all personal data is filled out as accurately and completely as possible so that our records are accurate and we get you registered in the correct division. If you have any special requests – specific team, multiple divisions, partner requests, position, etc. contact Jason Maurer via e-mail @ jmaurer@chaparralice.com. In Person @ NORTHCROSS: If you plan to go the payment plan route, you must register at Northcross during regular business hours. All payment plans MUST be set up according to the payment schedule on the previous page unless otherwise approved by the league director. Only credit or debit cards are accepted for the payment plan. No cash or bank acct/routing info is accepted for the payments. Cash is accepted for the initial down payment though.

Other: NO phone registration will be allowed. E-mail registration allowed if appropriate forms are filled out and e-mailed back completed prior to registration deadline. Contact league director to obtain copies of forms.

NOTES: Registration for a specific division does not guarantee that you will be playing in that division. Also, special requests will be noted, but there is no guarantee that we will be able to accommodate them. All requests – team, play-with, etc. – need to be e-mailed to the league director.

If you are a **NEW PLAYER** to the Chaparral Adult Hockey League, or have not played in the league since at least the Fall/Winter of 2016/17 season, make sure you enroll online for the specific division under the "New Player" category. For example, SKATER-A NEW, GOALIE-B1 NEW, etc. By doing so, you will be enrolled in the new player evaluation skate. Please be sure your contact info is valid because the league director will need to contact you for additional playing history information. Any current player in the league that is trying to move up in division is **STRONGLY** encouraged to sign up as a new player so that they may attend the NPS and be re-evaluated by the captains in the higher division.

New Player's Skate: See "Important Dates and Events". Please note that the times are subject to change. All new players will be contacted to instruct them as to which skate they need to attend as well as gather additional player information.

Playing in 2 divisions: Players will **not** be allowed to play in 2 divisions **unless** approved to do so by the league director. If interested in playing in two divisions, contact the league director. You will be put on a waiting list until registration is closed and it is determined if there are spots available for you to play in two divisions. However, you must be drafted in the higher division before you can be drafted in the lower division. Also, please note that if you are allowed to play in two leagues, there is no guarantee that your games will not be at conflicting times and locations.
