Terms & Conditions

Beginner Classes – 8-class session for Snowplow Sam 1-4 (ages 3-5 only), Basic 1-2 (ages 6+) and Adult 1-2

All skaters in our beginner classes are requested to wear a properly-fitted bicycle or multi-sport helmet (provided by the parent/skater).

- One 30-min. class per week (25 minutes of instruction), including skate rental
- Unlimited \$5 admissions with rental during public sessions
- Four “free” passes each 8 weeks, plus one “Bring a Friend to Public Session” pass
- Skill evaluation on last week of classes
- Learn to Skate USA Membership; Learn to Skate USA certificates and badges to recognize completion of class level

Intermediate/Advanced & Specialty Classes – 8-class session

Basic 3-8, Adult 3-6, Freeskate 1-6, Adult Freestyle Workshop, Most Specialty Classes

(Some specialty classes may be offered for different class/session durations, or different prices)

- One 30-min. class per week (25 minutes of instruction)
- Skate rental included for Basic 3-8 and Adult 3-6
- *Skaters in Freeskate or Specialty classes must have their own skates*
- Unlimited \$5 admissions with rental during public sessions
- Four “free” passes each 8 weeks, plus one “Bring a Friend to Public Session” pass
- Skill evaluation on last week of classes for regular curriculum classes
- Learn to Skate USA Membership; Learn to Skate USA badges for completion of class level

Discounts:

- Online registration – \$5 off all classes
- Multi-class/multi-family member discounts:
 - \$10 off additional immediate family members or additional enrollments by same student in 8-week classes (first skater full price)
 - Discounts will not be applied toward prorated enrollments. Prorated enrollments can only be authorized by Director of Figure Skating.

Refunds: There are no refunds. Class credits will be issued on an individual basis as authorized by the Director of Figure Skating.

Makeup Classes: Makeups for missed classes may be taken on any Learn to Skate day/time where the same class level is offered. **Makeups must be completed by the end of the current enrollment period and may not be extended into future sessions.**

Prorated Tuition: If you know you will miss classes during the session, please ask about prorating for the number of weeks you will attend. If you register for full session, makeup classes must be completed by end of session. ***Missed classes may not be carried over into future sessions!***

Evaluations: Assessments are conducted on the final week of classes (week 8 of 8-week classes). Students who pass a class will be given a Learn to Skate USA badge for that level (replacement badges \$2 each). A coach may evaluate a student mid-session and suggest they advance to the next level. In this event, the student may request the badge for the level passed at that time. If you have to miss the evaluation class, please contact the Director of Figure Skating before you miss in order to schedule a make-up evaluation. Many Basic Skills elements take several weeks to master. ***Completion of a session does not guarantee promotion to the next class level.*** Promotion will be based on proficiency of required skills, regardless of the number of times a skater has been enrolled in a level. Skaters must be able to pass all elements on test day to advance.

Class ID Card: Practice of skills learned in class is the most effective way to improve skills, and we encourage skaters to take advantage of the discounts offered on your class ID card. The discounts and passes on your class ID card are valid only for the duration of your current lesson session, and your card will be marked with an expiration date. The card may be used **ONLY** by the student whose name appears on the card. The card must be presented to the cashier to use free passes or Bring a Friend pass. **There is a \$10 fee for a replacement card (no additional free passes included).**

Class Stickers: Skaters must check in at the front desk before every class. Skaters will be issued a sticker with the name of the class, and that day's check-in date. Skaters must wear sticker in a visible location during class. Stickers will be checked to ensure skaters have checked in that day and are attending the correct class level.

Class Changes: Chaparral Ice reserves the right to combine, split, change, or cancel classes based on enrollment numbers. In the event of a cancellation, every effort will be made to place enrolled students in a comparable class.
