

Chaparral Ice Adult Hockey League

League Details - USA Hockey Registered League:

Adults aged 18 and up. Must have current USA Hockey registration. www.usahockey.com

Registration ends July 12, 2024, or once all spots are full. If registration fills, players will go on a waitlist.

Season starts Sunday, July 28, 2024, and will conclude by December 21, 2024, and includes 20 games.

Playoff format is single elimination with consolation bracket.

Game Details:

All games will be played at Chaparral Ice at Northcross

Games are non-check, three 13-minute stop clock periods with referees and scorekeepers. 3rd period mercy rule in effect (run clock during the third period only if the goal differential reaches six or more goals). Tie after regulation will immediately go to a 3-round shootout. Standings will be based upon a 3-point system.

Divisions and Game Night Details: *Final team #'s will depend on enrollment.

A Division = 6 teams* Primary Night: Wednesdays

B1 Division = 8 teams* Primary Night: Tuesdays/Sundays

B2 Division = 10 teams* Primary Night: Mondays/Sundays

C1 Division = 8 teams* Primary Night: Thursdays

C2 Division = 4 teams* Primary Night: Sundays

*Any player with a past due balance will not be allowed to register until their balance is paid in full

New Player Skate:

Players that are new to playing at Chaparral Ice (or have not played at Chaparral Ice in the last year) or players that are looking to move up a division, must attend new player skate on Saturday, July 13, 2024, between 7:00-10:15 pm.

Registration:

All players must register in person or online at www.chaparralice.com. When you register, make sure all personal data is filled out as accurately and completely as possible so that our records are accurate and you are registered in the correct division. Anyone wanting to play in multiple divisions must get permission from the league director prior to registration. Failure to get permission could result in dropping from a league.

Uniforms:

All players are required to wear matching jerseys with unique numbers (0-99). This includes goalies! Home team is generally light and away team is dark.

Special Notes:

Registration for a specific division does not guarantee that you will be playing in that division. Any special requests will be noted, but there is no guarantee that we will be able to accommodate them, this is a draft league. All requests (team, play with, etc.) need to be emailed to the league director.

Captains will notify teams of their roster and schedules shortly after completion of the draft.
