

## FAQS

### WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

Warm layered clothes and long pants are essential. Tall socks that cover the ankle must be worn with rental skates. **Skaters are required to wear a helmet and gloves (provided by skater).**

### WHERE DO I GO BEFORE CLASS?

Beginners should view the **Newcomer Orientation Videos** prior to arriving for the first day of class. You will receive an email with links to the videos and specific instructions on how to navigate your way to class. On the first day of class, please arrive 30 minutes before class time.

### DO I HAVE TO BUY MY OWN SKATES?

**Hockey Learn to Skate Classes:** Rental skates are provided at no charge. Rental skates are fine for beginners, but as you advance, the support and consistency of your own equipment will enhance your progress. Our pro shop is ready to help you buy your own skates.

**Hockey Learn to Play Classes:** Full gear is required for Learn to Play classes.

### WHAT IF I MISS A CLASS?

Makeup classes are included with your tuition! If you miss a class, you may attend on one of the other days your class is offered. Just check in as usual and tell the attendant the class/date you are making up. You may attend a makeup in advance of a planned absence. Please, no makeups during last week of class due to skaters being evaluated. (Contact skating director if you need to attend a makeup in last week of class.) No makeup lessons for Learn to Play. **All classes, makeups, and discounts expire at end of session.**

## FAQs

### SHOULD I PRACTICE OUTSIDE OF CLASS?

Skaters who practice regularly outside of class progress faster! We encourage skaters to take advantage of public session discounts to practice your skills.

### WHEN DO I GRADUATE?

Skaters advance once they can demonstrate proficiency in each level. Some skills take more than 8 weeks to master. At the end of each session we evaluate the players to see if they are ready to move up to Learn to Play.

### ADDITIONAL SAVINGS

**Multiple Registrations:** First class or family member full price, \$5 off additional classes or immediate family members.

**Prorated Tuition:** Can't make the whole session? We can prorate for the number of weeks you can attend. All make-up classes must be completed by end of session. **Missed classes may not be carried over to future sessions. Skaters who attend less than a full session might not pass.**
