Important Registration & Payment Information

- Registration is set up to charge show participation fees and may not reflect your actual rehearsal times/dates. Please see schedule sent by show directors for exact rehearsal times for your group/solo.
- Online registration available Aug. 31-Oct. 3.
- Show fees paid after Oct. 3 will be charged a \$25 late fee.
- Skaters who have not paid show fees by Oct. 17 will be removed from the show.

Participation Opportunities & Auditions

Group Performers

- All levels, Snowplow through Adult, beginners through advanced!
- No audition required.
- Skaters may perform in more than one group number (\$25 for additional numbers- contact director to request) (except Snowplow 1-3).
 - Skaters in multiple numbers may be required to attend rehearsals twice a week.
- No audition is required for group performers, but we must have full information on the registration to determine levels, abilities, and rehearsal schedules.

Leads in Group Numbers

- Small solos and “stepouts” as a part of a larger group number.
- Leads may be recruited from groups as show development progresses.

Soloists -*Interest form below in document*

- Audition required.
- Audition date TBD.
- Skaters must be in Free Skate 1 or above to audition.
- Soloists should be prepared to demonstrate their best jump, spin, and feature/fancy trick.
- Soloists will be required to work with a private coach outside of group rehearsal times for choreography.

- Private lesson fees for choreography and Chaparral Ice freestyle admission fees are the soloist's responsibility.
- Soloists, please see Show Director for rehearsal schedules/information.

Group Rehearsals

- Group rehearsals begin Saturday, Oct. 3 or Tuesday, Sept 29 at Northcross, depending on your group assignment.
- Regular weekly rehearsal times will be:
 - Tuesdays 6:30pm-7:30 p.m. (Adults)
 - Saturdays
 - 8:30-9:15 PFS-FS3, FS4-FS6
 - 9:00-9:45 Snowplow 1-3, Basic 1-3 and Basic 4-6
- **IMPORTANT: There are NO rehearsals on Tuesday 11/24 or Saturday 11/28/24 for Thanksgiving Week!**
- Additional off-ice rehearsals may be required, times TBD.
- Soloists, please see Show Director for rehearsal schedules/information.
- Cast absences negatively affect the production, rehearsal schedule, and show experience for all skaters. Attendance and absence policies below will be strictly adhered to.

Mandatory Dress Rehearsal

- Saturday, Nov. 21, 8:00-11:30 a.m.
- Regular Tuesday/Saturday rehearsals will still be held on Dec. 1, 5, 8, and 12th (after the dress rehearsal) to correct any last-minute problems. Please plan to attend your regular rehearsal time on those dates.
- More information about dress rehearsal to come later.

Performances

- Two performances: Saturday, Dec. 12, 6:30 p.m.; and Sunday, Dec. 13, 12 p.m.

Show Participation Fees

\$250 – CATEGORY 1: Group Performers Ages 6+

- Basic1- 6, Pre-Free Skate-Free Skate 6 and above, plus all adults.
- Includes all on-ice rehearsals/instruction, off-ice rehearsals as needed, dress rehearsal, and 2 performances.
- Skaters may perform in more than one group number, typically one before intermission and one after to allow for costume changes.

- Skaters who wish to perform in more than one group number must be willing to attend rehearsals for all assigned groups and purchase costumes for all numbers in which they appear.

\$150 – CATEGORY 2: Group Performance for Snowplow 1-3

- Skaters age 4-5.
- Includes all rehearsals/instruction as needed, dress rehearsal, and 2 performances.
- Snowplows will perform in a maximum of one group number and the opening number.
- The fee for Snowplows is reduced since they will be limited to one group number, and because these youngest performers may have limited attention spans and endurance. Since this is likely their first show experience, Snowplow rehearsals may be shorter than those for older skaters.

Additional Numbers (Same participant only)

ALL SOLOITS/SMALL GROUP SKATERS MUST PARTICIPATE IN A LARGE GROUP NUMBER ABOVE. ADDITIONAL NUMBERS ARE \$25 EACH. SUBMIT THE REQUEST FORM [HERE](#) !

Tickets

- Each skater will receive ONE free General Admission Ticket for a guest. A form will be sent out to redeem this ticket to registered performers only! Deadline to redeem this ticket will be sent in the email.
- EVERY PERSON WATCHING MUST HAVE A PURCHASED TICKET!!!

Fees, Discounts & Refunds

- Show participation fees are non-refundable. Account credit may be issued with a doctor's note and Chaparral Ice management approval.
- Multi-class, family, military and Skate More Save More discounts and makeup lessons do not apply to show fees.
- Show fees are not applicable with any other discounts, promotions, offers, etc.
- All show skaters will receive the \$6 public session rate during rehearsal season.
- Siblings are separate participants and do not qualify as an 'additional number'

Costumes

- Every effort will be made to keep costumes and costume fees no more than \$50 per costume.
- Exceptions may occur for highly-specialized costumes for specific roles.
- Skaters in multiple numbers must pay for required costumes for each number.

- Costumes must be secured no later than Friday, Nov. 6, so cast photos can be taken.
- Costume information will be emailed to show participants at a later date.

Volunteers

It takes a village to produce a show! Volunteers will be needed for many positions:

- Prop/set construction
- Cast wranglers (dressing rooms) *must be Safe Sport certified*
- Show setup and breakdown
- Ticket takers/admissions (no money handling necessary)
- Ushers

- For insurance purposes, all performers must be current members of Learn to Skate USA or United States Figure Skating. Please contact mindy@chaparralice.com if you have questions. (Note, Learn to Skate USA membership is included with Chaparral Ice Learn to Skate class registration. All skaters who have registered for a Learn to Skate session at Chaparral Ice since July 1, 2026, should have a current Learn to Skate USA membership. All participant registrations will be reviewed for memberships.)

- Skaters with more than 2 absences may be removed from the show.

- Dress rehearsal attendance on Saturday, Nov. 21 8:00-11:30 a.m., is MANDATORY. NO EXCEPTIONS.
